A little bit about us..

Fairfield Nursery opened in 2001, we are located on St Helens Rd close to Leigh town center. The nursery has two buildings within the grounds - the main building is a beautiful 3-story Georgian building providing facilities for Toddlers aged 2+ years, Pre-school children 3-4 years and holiday club 4-8 years with a separate period cottage within the grounds which is just for our Babies and Tinies under 2 yrs.

To the rear of the nursery we have a large car park for safe drop-off and pick-up. There are 3 separate outdoor play areas, with a combination of safety play surfaces, lawn, decking and natural areas to provide children with a wide variety of opportunities and experiences whilst enjoying outdoor play.

We are open from 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday all year round - we offer a comprehensive range of childcare packages - from full time attendance to short sessional care (1 or 2 sessions a week) we also offer a full range of Government funded sessions for ages 2 to 4 yrs. We offer a sibling discount of 5% on children attending from the same family and/or a 5% discount to NHS, Fire, Police and Armed Services personnel.

Our Staff

We are proud of our staff team, in addition to their professional qualifications and experience our staff are also selected for their passion in the care and education of babies and young children. Our recruitment methods are rigorous, so in addition to verbal and written references new employees undergo an enhanced DBS (Disclosure and Barring Service) Criminal Records Bureau check prior to starting employment, we also subscribe staff to the DBS Update Service so that we can carry out ongoing update checks on a regular basis.

The majority of staff at Fairfield are qualified to a minimum of Level 3 NVQ or equivalent with some staff qualified at Level 4 & 5 and up to level 6 (Degree level). Staff are encouraged to continue with their professional development and many choose to continue studying for enhanced level qualifications. It is nursery policy for all nursery staff to be trained in Paediatric First Aid, which is renewed every three years

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Our Ethos

We aim to provide a high standard of professional child care where children feel safe and happy at all times. We believe strongly in working in partnership with parents/carers, encouraging children to be independent, to achieve through hands on experience, exploration, risk assessment, creative and critical thinking, problem solving and teamwork. Our staff work hard to ensure children are presented with a wealth of opportunities to excite, explore and challenge them whilst building strong, secure relationships with their peers and staff in a happy, safe environment.

It is important to all our team to provide a truly warm welcome and friendly atmosphere for children, their families, friends, staff and visitors, and to provide a full range of opportunities to meet the needs of individual children whilst giving equal opportunity for all.

We share a variety of important cultural celebrations and special events with all the children encouraging them to embrace difference in all things. We encourage a sense of community through discussion, role play, local celebrations and outings and by promoting 'British Values' at all times children are encouraged to be kind, value relationships and respect the feelings, beliefs and cultures of others.

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The Baby Cottage



Our baby cottage caters for Babies and Tinies up to 2 yrs, this is a separate facility away from the main nursery building, the baby cottage enables us to provide a gentle introduction to nursery for young babies in a quiet homely environment.


We know it can be a little daunting leaving your little one at nursery for the first time, however we want to reassure you that all our baby room practitioners have the experience & skills to ensure your child is cared for in the best possible way. Providing a stimulating, learning environment to support their emotional well being as they develop and grow.

We encourage as much physical development as possible at this early stage, climbing, crawling and walking is just the beginning! Our very own baby decking area and gazebo is set up for safe outdoor play in all weathers!

We often take advantage of our large safe homely spaces by using a 'free flow' approach - this means our Tinies children can choose which area they would like to explore between both rooms.

Young children and babies need a variety of sensory activities and experiences including textures, smells and colours for their early stages of development - this is why we create exciting sensory trays and use sand/water play both indoor and outdoor!



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Toddlers

Our large and exciting Toddler rooms are perfect for your little one to explore! At this age we will begin to introduce numbers and letters, however we encourage learning through play and exploring!

They will have the opportunity to enjoy arts & crafts, role play, construction, sensory & malleable play, water and sand- and much more!



Our toddlers are cared for with a minimum staff to child ratio of 1 team member to every 4 children.

This enables your child's key person to support their emotional and physical development whilst providing them with learning activities based on their individual curiosities, needs and interests.



Our Toddler room is on the ground floor and runs over two spacious rooms with large windows, allowing lots of natural light; creating a calm and inviting environment.

At this age physical play is vital and although we relish the time playing outside we also provide a range of activities such as music and movement, yoga, group activities in our workshop room 'The Hub' - located opposite our Toddler room!

Our environments both indoors and outdoors have lots of opportunities for all the physical experiences two year old's naturally engage in. And while open areas are vital for active play, we also provide cosy and enclosed spaces to invite our children to withdraw and relax - a place to suit all children.



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Pre-School

Our focus in Pre-School is to make sure your child is ready for their next steps onto school both educationally and socially.

Our qualified Pre-school team have a ratio of 1 member per 8 children. The Key Person will consider the individual needs, interests and stage of development of each child in their care and use this information to plan a challenging and enjoyable experience for each child in all areas of learning and development.

Your child's education will cover all areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS), so they will be fully prepared for primary school.

Children learn best when they are happy and engaged in what they are doing, which is why we use your child's interest to inspire our learning activities.

With varied areas set up to promote independent learning and choice, such as mark making, home role play, construction, creative, sand and water play, both indoor and outdoor!



Each area of learning & development is implemented through planned, purposeful play and through a mix of adult-led and child-initiated activity. Play is essential for children's development, building their confidence as they learn to explore, problem solve & relate to others in a social learning environment.


We will make sure you're always involved in your child's learning journey, so we can all work together to give them the best possible start.

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Natural Outdoor Spaces




We have fabulous large play areas for all ages including gazebos for all weathers! Our children are encouraged to explore, play and learn in a natural environment with safe surroundings.

Healthy Meals & Menu's

Here at Fairfield Nursery, we will provide your children with home-cooked, healthy meals daily with the addition of fruit snacks, and milk throughout the day - water is available in every room at all times.

Our aim is to provide your children with a balanced diet, with ample opportunity to eat fruit and vegetables everyday. Our team here at the nursery work hand in hand with our cook, to create delicious, nutritious menu's which run on a 3 week rotation. We alter our menu's in line with the seasons to use local produce all year round.

As well as the two main meals per day, children have a breakfast provided on arrival with an additional snack mid-morning and mid-afternoon all included.

FREE SESSIONS (FUNDED ONLY) 15 Hours F/O : Free 15 hrs can be taken in term time as 3 x 5 hour sessions or 1 x 10 hr day & 1 x 5 hr session or 'stretched' over 52 wks at Managers discretion and subject to availability - see above.

30 Hours F/O : Government funding is paid in term time only. If your child attends all year and you are paying a wrap-around price your child can attend during any of our opening hours i.e. 7am to 6pm. If you have taken a free place (funded only) and you also need your child to attend BEFORE 8am you can pay a top up of £5per hr. Please note due to staffing arrangements, early attendance is NOT available on a casual basis, it must be booked for the full term and will be charged weekly whether used or not.
